REQUIREMENT TO POST LINK TO IMRF WEBSITE

This Memorandum reminds Public Libraries (IMRF participants) of the need to post on the Library's website a link to certain IMRF information.

Per Public Act 101-0504 effective July 1, 2020 (copy attached), there are new IMRF website posting requirements, i.e.:

- A. IMRF must post on the IMRF website certain information, i.e.:
 - 1. Copies of all resolutions adopted by a municipality on or after January 1, 1995 to participate in the Fund if such a resolution was required;
 - 2. An annual report listing each municipality and the date each municipality first became a municipality that participates in the Fund;
 - 3. All documents pertaining to each municipality's annual projected future contributions under this Article; and
 - 4. Information about the amount of each municipality's past required contributions to the Fund for each year of participation on or after January 1, 1995 and before, if available.

(Note: The statute refers to "municipality" which includes Public Libraries and other IMRF participants) (40 ILCS 5/7-105).

B. On or before January 1, 2021, Libraries must post on the Library's website a link to the information posted on the IMRF website, i.e.:

A municipality that has a website shall post to its website, no later than January 1, 2021, a link to the information provided by the Fund . . .

The link to be posted on the Library website is to the IMRF's "Employer Cost & Participation Information" (see attached).

AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding Section 7-135.5 as follows:

(40 ILCS 5/7-135.5 new)

Sec. 7-135.5. Required public posting of information by the Fund.

- (a) The Fund shall post on its publicly available website the following information regarding municipalities that participate in the Fund that the Fund has in its possession:
 (1) copies of all resolutions adopted by a municipality on or after January 1, 1995 to participate in the Fund if such a resolution was required; (2) an annual report listing each municipality and the date each municipality first became a municipality that participates in the Fund; (3) all documents pertaining to each municipality's annual projected future contributions under this Article; and (4) information about the amount of each municipality's past required contributions to the Fund for each year of participation on or after January 1, 1995 and before, if available.
- (b) A municipality that has a website shall post to its website, no later than January 1, 2021, a link to the information provided by the Fund under this Section. A municipality that establishes a website on or after January 1, 2021 shall post to its website a link to the information provided by the Fund under this Section.
- (c) This Section does not require the Fund to post on its website information that is exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act.

This Section does not require a municipality to establish or maintain a website.

Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding Section 8.43 as follows:

(30 ILCS 805/8.43 new)

Sec. 8.43. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2020.

In 2019, the Illinois General Assembly passed Public Act 101-0504. The law requires IMRF to post certain employer cost and participation information on its website. IMRF will update these reports annually.

- Employer Contribution Amounts: The amount of employer contributions each employer made from 1/1/1995 to present (searchable spreadsheet)
- Employer Contribution Rates: Each employer's contribution rates for the current year and one year after (searchable spreadsheet)
- Participating Employers: A list of all employers and the date each employer joined IMRF (searchable spreadsheet)
- Employer Resolutions: Required participation resolutions for employers that joined on or after 1/1/1995 (searchable PDF)

Public Act 101-0504 requires IMRF employers that have a website to include a link to this web page, no later than January 1, 2021.
